



Critical support to safeguard livestock-based livelihoods, improve food and nutrition security and sustain income of most vulnerable rural people affected by multiple climatic and economic shocks in Afghanistan

Objective

To improve the livelihoods and food security of vulnerable livestock-keeping households.

Activities implemented

- Trained ten implementing partners' personnel on good livestock and poultry management practices.
- Distributed 800 tonnes of concentrate feed and 12 tonnes of fodder seed to 4 000 households (28 975 people); and trained them on good livestock management practices.
- Administered 108 litres of deworming medicine to 24 919 small and large ruminants, belonging to the participating households.
- Distributed 63 000 poultry, 315 tonnes of compound poultry feed, 2 100 sets of poultry coop materials, 4 200 feeders, and 4 200 drinkers to 2 100 households (15 442 people); and trained them on good poultry management practices.

Results

- Enhanced the knowledge of implementing partners' personnel and the participating households on good livestock and poultry management practices, thanks to the project's training activities.
- Enabled 4 000 households to improve the health and productivity of their livestock; and produce around 32 000 tonnes of fodder, thanks to the distribution of concentrate feed, fodder seeds and administration of deworming medicine.
- Enabled 2 100 households to diversify their sources of livelihoods and access a sustainable supply of eggs and poultry meat, thanks to the distribution of poultry production inputs.
- Contributed to improving the livelihoods and food security of the targeted communities, thanks to increased food production capacities.
