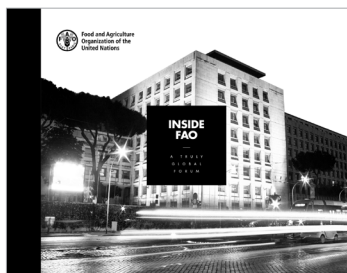

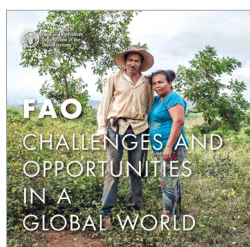

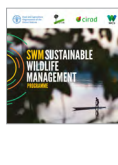

**Report of the eleventh meeting of the RECOFI
Working Group on Fisheries Management, Muscat,

The meeting addressed Illegal, Unreported and Unregulated (IUU) fishing-related issues, provided updates on the ongoing work on RECOFI priority species (e.g. Green Tiger Prawn, Blue swimming crabs), and discussed data collection challenges.

This assessment framework provides a basis for understanding the impact of community-based forestry on forests and local livelihoods at the country level (e.g. improvement in forest governance).
