MEMBERSHIP OF THE WFP EXECUTIVE BOARD

- 1. In accordance with Resolution 6/99 adopted by the 30th Session of the FAO Conference on 13 November 1999¹, the Council is required to elect six members of the WFP Executive Board for a term of office of three years from among FAO Member Nations.
- 2. For purposes of election to the Board, FAO Member Nations are divided into five separate lists (A, B, C, D and E) as shown on the FAO Council Web page at: http://www.fao.org/unfao/bodies/council/cl140/Index en.htm.
- 3. The Council at its 140th Session will therefore be required to elect six members for a term of office expiring on 31 December 2013 to replace the ones whose term ends on 31 December 2010, i.e. Canada (List D), Democratic Republic of the Congo (List A), Germany (List D), Guinea (List A), Haiti (List C), and Kuwait (List B).
- 4. Outgoing members are eligible for re-election.
- 5. A nomination form is given in <u>Appendix A</u>. The deadline for submission of nominations to the Secretary-General of the Conference and Council is **12.00 hours on Monday 15 November 2010**. The election of the above six members will take place at the 140th Session of the FAO Council.
- 6. Through the above mentioned Resolution 6/99, the FAO Conference decided to review the distribution of WFP Executive Board seats two years before the end of one full rotation scheme of four terms, taking into account the relevant inputs of the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) and the FAO Council. ECOSOC is expected to make a recommendation on the composition of the WFP Executive Board to the 65th Session of the United Nations General Assembly, which opened in New York on 14 September 2010. The General Assembly is expected to adopt a resolution on the matter. The FAO Council, at its 141st Session in April 2011, will be invited to examine and endorse a parallel draft Conference resolution and forward it to the
