## **EUROPEAN SOIL PARTNERSHIP**

In the framework of the Second Global Soil Week on 31 October 2013 in Berlin, Germany, European partners to the Global Soil Partnership met in the workshop "Towards a European Regional/Sub-regional Soil Partnership".

After an active discussion, participating partners decided to:

- Establish the European Soil Partnership whose Secretariat is based in Ispra (Italy).
- Endorse the establishment of a Sub-regional Soil Partnership within the European Soil Partnership whose Secretariat would be based in Moscow (Russian Federation).
- Establish an ad-hoc Steering Committee for the European Regional Soil Partnership comprising the following members:
  - o European Commission (Joint Research Centre)
  - o Soil Science and Conservation Research Institute, Slovakia
  - o Institute for Advanced Sustainability Studies (IASS), Germany
  - o Eurasian Centre for Food Security (ECFS), Russian Federation
  - o European Soil Bureau Network (ESBN)
- Appoint the Joint Research Centre of the European Commission as the Secretariat to the European Regional Soil Partnership.
- Hold the launch meeting of the Eurasian Sub-Regional Soil Partnership in Moscow on 20 November 2013.
- Hold the next meeting of the European Regional Soil Partnership in the first semester of 2014.
- Prepare appropriate working documents for the next meetings to inform the debate. Such documents would, if at all possible, be sent four weeks in advance of the respective meetings.
