### REPORTS FROM INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS AND INSTRUMENTS

1. At its Fourteenth Regular Session, the Commission on Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture (Commission) adopted the Strategic Plan 2014-2023 as the planning and implementation framework to assist Members of the Commission, the Bureau and the Secretariat of the Commission, FAO and other organizations to contribute to the implementation of its Multi-Year Programme of Work. According to its strategic plan, the Commission aims to actively increase synergies and strengthen partnerships with all stakeholders involved with genetic resources for food and agriculture.

The Secretariat of the Intergovernmental Technical Working Group on PGRFA requested and received from various international organizations reports on activities undertaken by them in relation to plant genetic resources. Members are invited to consider the reports contained in the following documents: *Report from the Global Crop Diversity Trust to the Intergovernmental Technical Working Group on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture (CGRFA/WG-PGR-7/14/Inf.9)*, *Report from the International Union for the Protection of New Varieties of Plants to the Intergovernmental Technical Working Group on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture (CGRFA/WG-PGR-7/14/Inf.10)*, *Report from the International Treaty on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture to the Intergovernmental Technical Working Group on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture (CGRFA/WG-PGR-7/14/Inf.11)*.
3. Given the importance of the activities reported and the relevance of these activities to the work of the Working Group and the Commission, the Working Group may wish to recommend that the Commission and the Working Group continue to receive reports from relevant instruments and organizations.
