## What is a sustainable food value chain?

A *food value chain* consists of all the stakeholders that participate in the coordinated production and value adding activities that are needed to make food products.

A *sustainable food value chain*:

- » is profitable throughout **[economic sustainability]**;
- » has broad-based benefits for society **[social sustainability]** and
- » shows a positive or neutral impact on the natural environment **[environmental sustainability]**

# » What is SFVC development?

SFVC development is a market-oriented and systems-based approach. Its purpose is to create value that will be distributed equitably among the chain actors, benefiting as many poor households as possible. At the same time, the approach aims at greening the value chain.

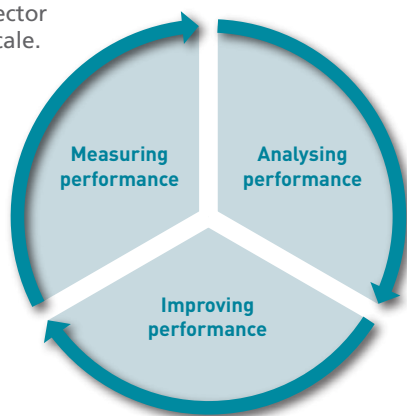
The SFVC development approach follows a continuous cycle of three phases (analysing, improving and measuring performance) and is focused on upgrading:

## ✳ Upgrading strategies

Need to be linked to end-market opportunities and vision development. They typically require collaboration among a wide range of private and public sector stakeholders and aim to achieve impact at scale.

## ✳ Upgrading activities

Are designed to focus on those parts of the value chain (VC) where the largest impact on profitability, inclusiveness and the greening of the value chain can be achieved.



## » Why SFVC development?

The development of SFVC can offer important pathways out of poverty through broad-based job creation, income growth and wealth build up, in a socially and environmentally sustainable manner.

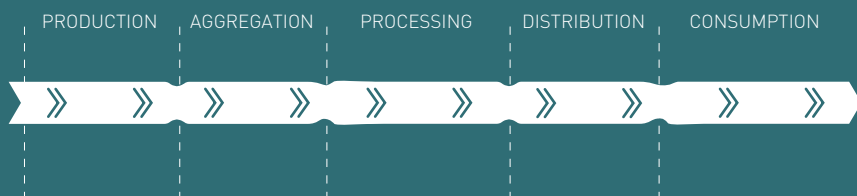
It is therefore not surprising that the interest in SFVC development has strongly grown in recent years, especially among agro-industries, donors and development practitioners.
