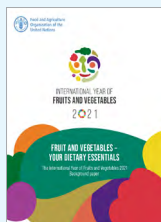

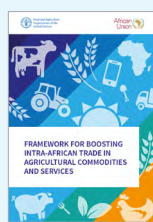


Looking at edible insects from a food safety perspective – Challenges and opportunities for the sector
