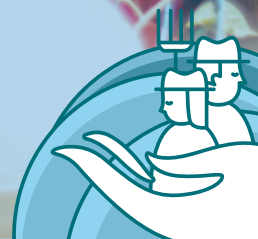

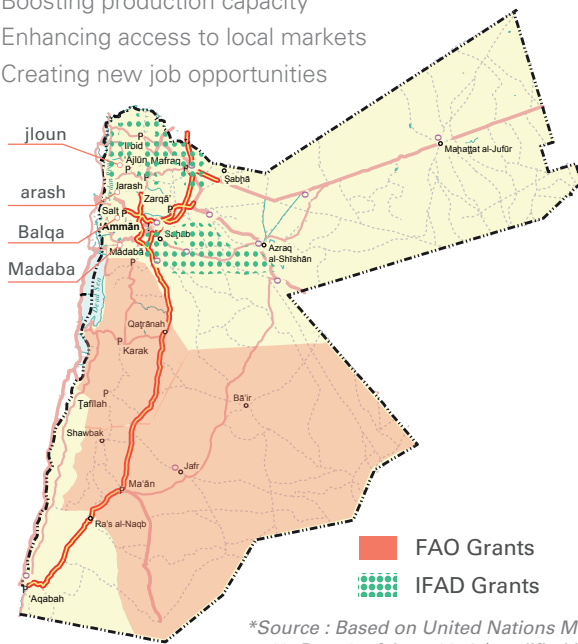

- Providing support to build confidence and reinforce skills to establish and sustain agricultural businesses
- Boosting production capacity
- Enhancing access to local markets
- Creating new job opportunities

### Grants

- USD 3.1 M** In grants for vulnerable smallholder farmers and/or farmers' groups with labor-intensive operations
- 1 150** Vulnerable households from among the Jordanian host communities and the Syrian refugees supported financially and technically  
**300** Grants awarded by FAO and **850** grant beneficiaries by IFAD
- 1 500** New labor jobs created for laborers matching the agreed vulnerability criteria

**Target beneficiaries:** Ministry of agriculture, small and medium scale farmers, Syrian refugees and host communities workers.

**Government/partners/other counterparts:** WFP, IFAD, MoA, JRF, JOHUD, NAF
