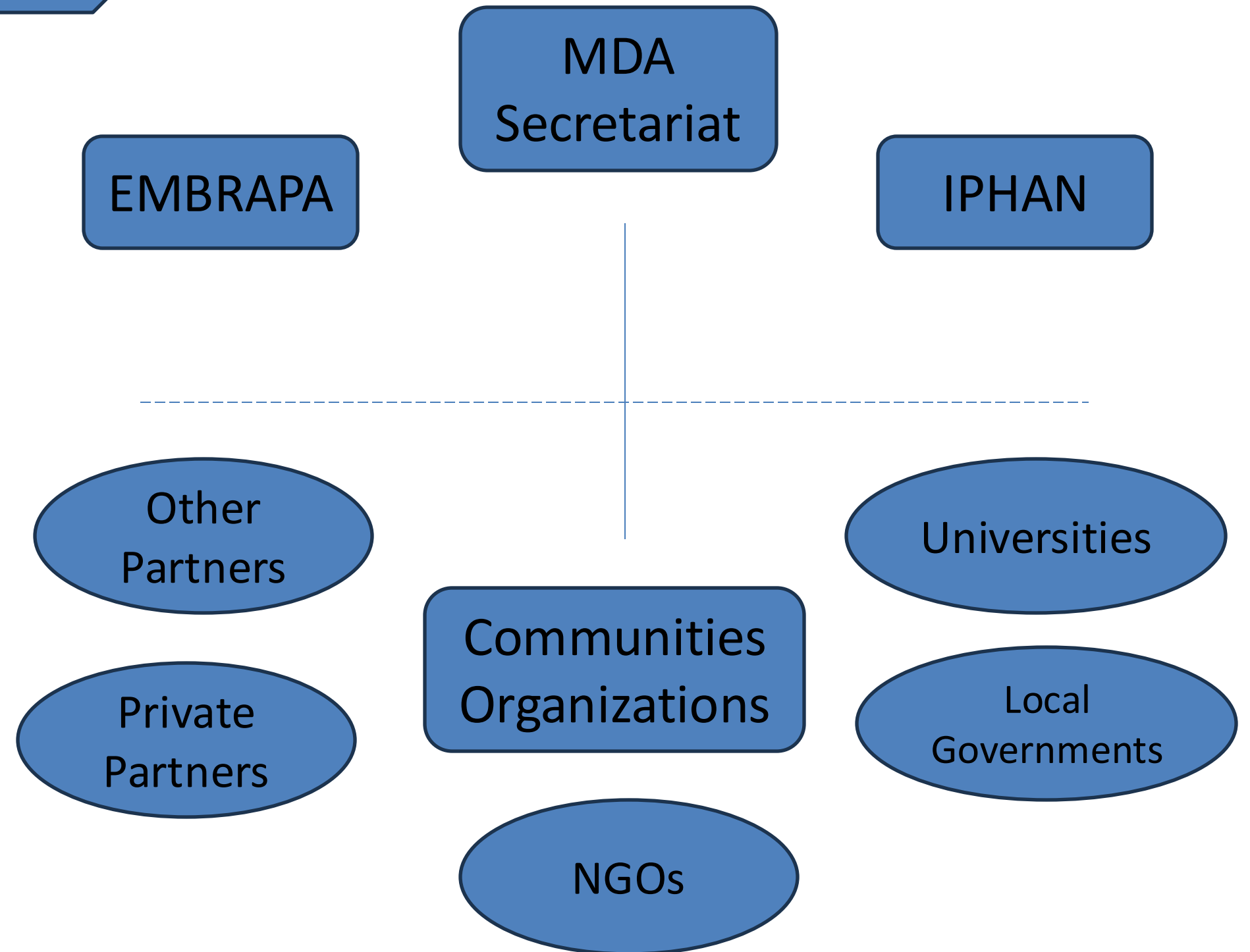

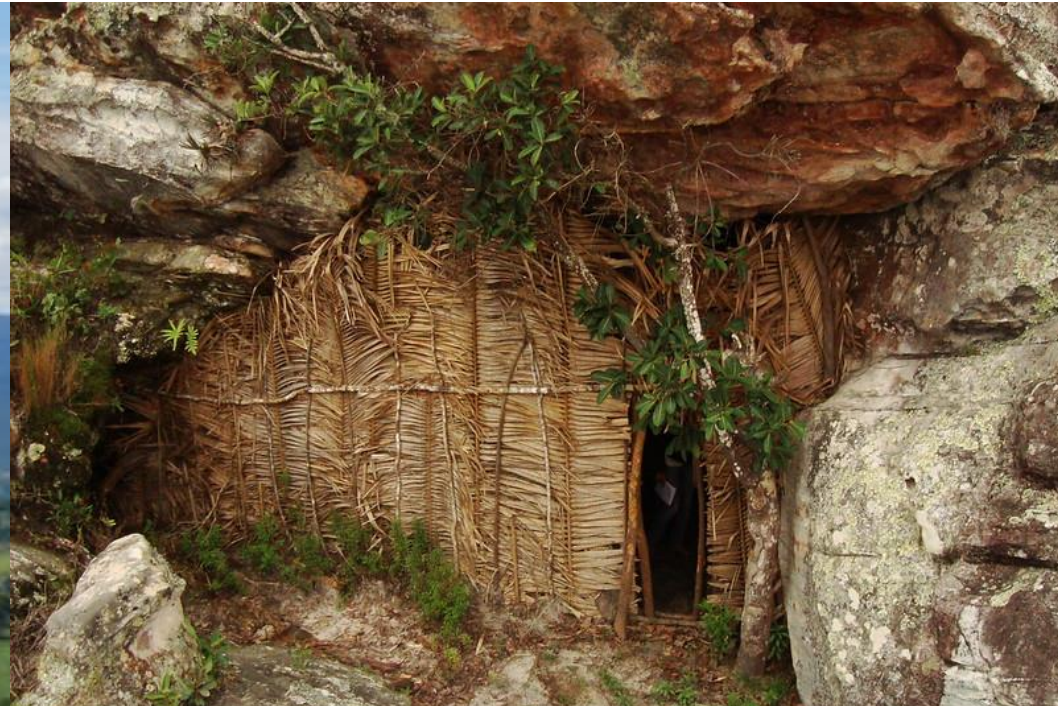

Traditional Agricultural System in Southern Espinhaço Range



- ✓ Complex System based on the transhumance of communities throughout an altitudinal landscape
- ✓ Rainy Season – Foothills
- ✓ Dry season – Mountainous collective fields

Reasons for applying to GIAHS

- ✓ National Level
 - ✓ Brazilian potential for the program
 - ✓ Giahs as a strategy to strengthen rural communities, political, sociocultural and economically

- ✓ Community Level
 - ✓ GIAHS as a tool to Territorial rights and access to natural resources
 - ✓ Political strengthening of Rural communities
 - ✓ Increased visibility
 - ✓ Improve income Generation, food security and livelihoods
