Celebrating FAO Library’s anniversary with a video on its long history and unique agricultural research collection



To celebrate FAO Library’s anniversary, please enjoy this short [video](#), highlighting the library’s history, collections, and services for both FAO staff and external researchers.

The David Lubin Memorial Library was officially founded in Rome on June 10, 1952. It was named in honour of David Lubin who championed the foundation of the International Institute of Agriculture (IIA) in Rome in 1905. The IIA was the first international organization established in support of agricultural research and development and was the predecessor of FAO.

Upon establishment, FAO started building its own library collection on top of the 400,000 publications it had inherited from the IIA.

Today, FAO Library has collected over 1.5 million publications. This extensive collection consists of both print and digital literature, as well as FAO’s institutional memory, 400 rare books and a rich collection of books and journals by other publishers covering all fields of research within the Organization.
