#### Side Event

## Wireless Internet Service

FAO is currently piloting a Wireless Internet Service. The service is available in the main Meeting Rooms (Red and Green Rooms), as well as the Atrium, Cuba Room, David Lubin Library, Korean Lounge, Nordic Lounge, German Room, Pakistan Room, Gabon Room, Mexico Room, Philippines Room, UEMOA Meeting Room, Slovak Business Centre.

Council participants with a laptop or PDA (Personal Digital Assistant) which has Wireless LAN capabilities, conforming to the 802.11b or 802.11g standards, are welcome to use this free service.

There are three steps to take in order to connect to the service:

Step 1: Turning on laptop or PDA, while in the Atrium.

Step 2: Allowing laptop or PDA to detect the network "guest\_internet".

Step 3: Opening a browser and trying to connect to an Internet site. The following username and password should be used :

[Username: visitor: Password: connect2web]

Please note that no support can be provided if problems arise when connecting to, or using, the wireless internet service.

## Telephone Facilities for Participants

Telephones for internal or Rome calls are located in the Slovak Centre (Ground Floor of Building B), and in the corridor of the first floor of Building A. Before making calls from the Rome area dial "0" and wait for the external dial tone before dialing the number.

International phone calls can also be made using calling cards, on sale at the newsstand in front of the *Banca Intesa*. Calls can be made at discount rates by using these cards on the phones in the Slovak Business Centre.

## Postal and Courier/DHL Service for Delegates

The Italian Post Office, located on the Ground Floor of Building B (adjacent to the bank office), *Banca Intesa* will provide normal services for stamps, parcels, telex, telegrams, registered mail, currency exchange, postal/money orders, etc. The Post Office is open from 08.25 to 15.30 hours Monday to Friday.
