



## **The 6<sup>th</sup> High Level Training and Experience Sharing on Globally Important Agricultural Heritage Systems (GIAHS) under the Framework of South-South Cooperation (SCC)**

**Time:** 16 – 25 September 2019

**Location:** Beijing and field sites (GIAHS/NIAHS sites in Huzhou, Tongling and Anxi)

### **Objectives:**

- To enhance capacity of high-level/senior staff of GIAHS national focal points (government officers and academicians) to implement GIAHS activities in their respective countries;
