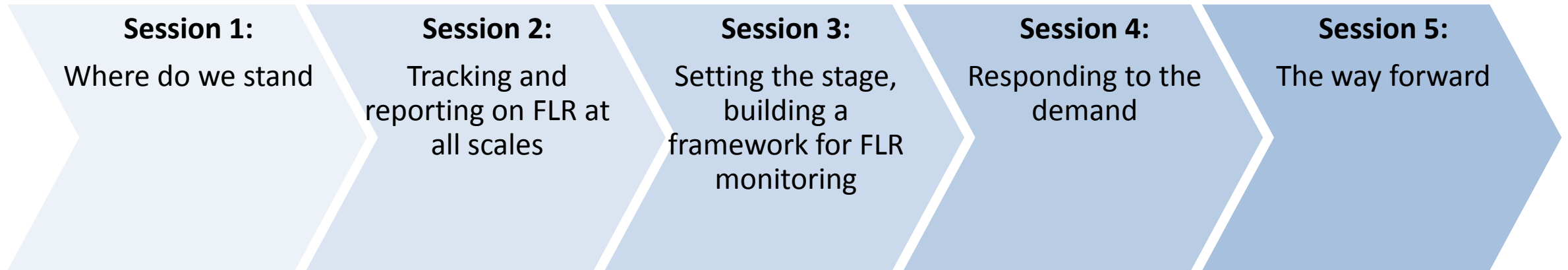


# The drylands and FLR monitoring week

## Case Studies of monitoring restoration

- Presentation of 3 different cases in 3 different continents using 3 different approaches
- Difficulties/Challenges in monitoring socio-economic aspects
- Use of existing data, to the extent possible
- Need of linking monitoring at both national and local level
  - Scaling up from project level
  - Maintaining the monitoring after project is over (continuity!)
- Monitoring according to targets
  - Link to SDGs, UNCCD, other international commitments
- Selection of indicators
  - Keep them simple and realistic
  - Participatory approach involving all stakeholders

### Session 3 – Setting the stage, building a framework for FLR n

#### Defining the demand: What countries need to monitor?

- Key aspects to monitor: Ambition (Objectives) – Action (Restoration) – Outcomes (Benefits, Side effects)
- Importance of reporting, not only to international processes but also to investors, politicians and citizens
- Monitoring process improves the restoration itself
- Consideration of different scales critical while defining indicators, collecting information and communicating results
- Relationship between global level & groups of actors
  1. Light reporting strategy to the government
  2. Citizen / science approach
  3. Citizen observatory approach
- Monitoring has to be done from local to global
