- Reinforce knowledge - train of trainers (Hire trained Indigenous Peoples)
- Strengthen the capacities of national Indigenous Peoples organizations when selecting countries.
- Strategic alliances with government and other initiatives.
- Local communities exchanges – peer-to-peer exchanges
- In LAC, there is a governance institutional framework on IPs, technical experiences on the part of IP's national organizations in forest monitoring, and sufficient technical capacity to empower and support other regions.
