a) Table 3.11 following paragraph 3.68 should read (corrected figures underlined):

b) Paragraph 3.68 should read as follows, reflecting the corrections in Table 3.11 (corrections underlined):

Para. 3.68

As shown in Table 3.11, 32.4% of the projects had budgets equal or below US\$ 50 000. In terms of allocations, the highest concentration was to be found in the US\$ 51 000 - 300 000 range, accounting for some 87% of total project approvals. Only 4.5% of the total allocation, or 22 projects, equivalent to only 1.4% of the total number of projects, had budgets over US\$ 300 000. This confirms the continuing thrust of TCP on small-scale interventions.
