INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS WITH WHICH FORMAL RELATIONS HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED SINCE 1989

Intergovernmental Organizations (IGOs)

1. Since the last session of the Conference, formal relations have been established, through the signature of a Memorandum of Understanding on 29 September 1993, between FAO and the Group of Latin American and Caribbean Sugar-Exporting Countries. Also since November 1991, the following two IGOs have ceased functioning: the International Jute Organization and the International Wool Study Group. The European Economic Community became an FAO Member and therefore no longer appears in the list of IGOs with formal relations with the Organization. The total number of IGOs with status is 102.

International Non-Governmental Organizations (INGOs)

2. Consultative Status has not been granted to any INGO since the last session of the Conference. The number of organizations with Consultative Status remains at 16.

3. The status of the World Council of Credit Unions has been upgraded from Liaison to that of Specialized Consultative Status, bringing the total number of Organizations in this category to 55.

4. In view of the above upgrading the total number of organizations with Liaison Status is 110.
