

Global and regional food availability from 2000 to 2017 – An analysis based on Supply Utilization Accounts data
 The analysis indicates that food availability for consumption differs across income-level country groups. The lower-middle-income countries are highly dependent on staple foods while only the upper-middle-income countries and Asia have enough fruits and vegetables available to meet the recommended consumption.
