Introductory Items¹

1. The 173rd Session of the Council was held on 10 July 2023 under the Chairpersonship of Mr Hans Hoogeveen, Independent Chairperson of the Council.
2. The Session was convened in a hybrid modality, on an exceptional basis without creating a precedent, with some representatives attending in person at FAO headquarters, and others participating virtually.
3. The Council confirmed, pursuant to Rule VIII of the Rules of Procedure of the Council, that it agreed to the suspension of any rules incompatible with the hybrid setting, specifically Rule II.3 of the Rules of Procedure of the Council, which provides that each session of the Council shall be held at the seat of the Organization.

Adoption of the Agenda²

4. The Council noted the Declaration of Competence and Voting Rights presented by the European Union and adopted the Agenda for the Session.
5. The Council approved the methods of work outlined in document CL 173/INF/2, *Methods of Work for the 173rd Session of the Council*.
