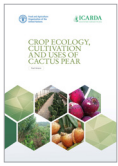

AGRICULTURE



Crop ecology, cultivation and uses of cactus pear—Final version

An overview of cactus pears' features and uses, including human and medical consumption, restoration of degraded lands, or fodder, as in Brazil, where a 400,000 ha plantation in the northeast is supporting livestock production in semi-arid areas. (244 pp.) FAO & ICARDA

ANIMAL PRODUCTION AND HEALTH



Intervening against bovine trypanosomiasis in eastern Africa: mapping the costs and benefits

An analysis of economic losses from Tsetse-transmitted trypanosomiasis in Ethiopia, Kenya, Somalia, South Sudan, Sudan and Uganda. Results were used to generate a cost–benefit map of approaches used to tackle the disease and identify the most viable ones. (124 pp.) Paat Technical and scientific series

FISHERIES AND AQUACULTURE



GLOBEFISH Highlights – Issue 4, 2017

This report foresees growth in global fish production of 2.3 percent in 2017, with aquaculture production rising by some 4–5 percent a year. Prices for many seafood commodities have increased due to rising demand driven by economic growth, especially in Latin America and Asia. (72 pp.)



Report of the sixteenth session of the Sub-Committee on Fish Trade of the Committee on Fisheries. Busan, Republic of Korea, 4–8 September 2017

Questions covered by the session included food loss and waste, social sustainability (e.g. the role of women), the role of Marine Protected Areas (MPAs) (e.g. closer cooperation with national authorities) and the impact of climate change on fish supply, trade and consumption. (68 pp., trilingual)

FOOD SECURITY AND NUTRITION



Approval of a new food act in Chile: process summary

This overview of the 2016 Chilean food labelling law is now available in English. It sets out the objectives of the law, explains the different implementation phases, reviews its dissemination strategy and addresses drivers and challenges to implementation. Strengthening sector policies for better food security and nutrition results: Rural migration
